SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The La Crosse Area Occupational Safety & Health Council (LAOSHC) is pleased to offer a \$500 scholarship award to students pursuing a degree in a safety or health field. The Council seeks candidates who will use their training to provide safety and/or health related services and support for area employers. In addition, the award will include a free one-year membership in the LAOSHC.

The La Crosse Area Occupational Safety and Health Council is a local safety council serving La Crosse and the surrounding communities. The LAOSHC is affiliated with the Wisconsin Council of Safety (WCS), a state-level safety council which is a chapter of the National Safety Council.

The goal of the LAOSHC is to promote safety and health among its members and the community. The Council assists area employers in promoting public and occupational safety and health in cooperation with other organizations with similar objectives.

The Council is a civic, non-profit, and non-political organization.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Eligible students must be enrolled in a safety or health related field at a La Crosse area campus, including Western Technical College, Viterbo University, or University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. In addition, the Council will consider applications from students, originating from within our membership area, that are seeking a health or safety related degree at other colleges or universities.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Applicants must submit the following, to be considered:

1. Name, current address and telephone number.
2. University or Technical College and major enrolled in.
3. Two faculty reference letters on department letterhead.
4. Current academic transcripts.
5. List of extra curricular activities, including community involvement.
6. A one-page statement listing qualifications and career objectives.
